Civil tax litigation in the United States takes place in several possible venues. The vast majority of civil tax litigation is filed in the United States Tax Court (Tax Court), a legislatively created (Article I) court that began life as the Board of Tax Appeals, an executive branch agency.<sup>1</sup>
