Throughout the 1920s and 1930s, the Red Cross released updated knitting and sewing guidelines for volunteers, slowly shifting from providing complete knitting and sewing patterns to recommending specific commercially available sewing patterns for volunteers and printing their own knitting patterns. The Red Cross continued to update their knitting and sewing patterns over the twenty years between the First and Second World War.

During World War II, knitting served as one of the more prevalent ways individuals on the home front could support the war effort. To fill this gap, the American Red Cross began a national knitting campaign. Red Cross branches distributed yarn, advertised the need for knitwear, and distributed standard patterns for the most needed items. Women from all over the country, from college students to grandmothers, promised to knit for "Sammy."

Pattern description from Knitting America: This pattern comes from Red Cross instructions reprinted in various publications during World War I. Size: The official Red Cross sock measured 11 inches from heel to toe and 14 inches from tip of heel to top of leg ribbing. Materials: 2 Pair No. 1 Red Cross Steel Needles (metric 3 1/2); 1.5 Hanks (3/8 lb.) Knitting Yarn.
